5. Insurance

National Insurance:	All international students who stay in Japan for three months or
	longer shall join the Japanese government-funded National
	Health Insurance. It covers 70 % of your medical cost in most
	cases. The premium costs approximately 1500 yen per month.
Personal Accident	The accident insurance policy covers injuries caused during
Insurance and Liability	classes, school events and commuting. All APU students are
Insurance	required to take out the insurance. The Personal Liability
	Insurance which covers a part of payment against damages
	which, during the period of the insurance, they may be held
	legally liable to pay for an injuring third party or a damage of
	any property belonging to the third party is also mandated by
	APU. They cost 1340 yen in total per year.
Bicycle Insurance	It has been ruled to purchase some bicycle insurance if you plan
	to use it.

7. Visa Process

1. APU receives the necessary information for CoE application,
photo data and other documents. (3 months prior to arrival)
2. APU sends them to the Immigration Bureau via the website.
3. APU receives the actual CoE and dispatches to the home
institution. (1.5 month prior to arrival)
4. The student visits the Embassy of Japan or Consular Office to
be issued the Student Visa.
